BILL NO. HB352

Analysis

HB 352 is a comprehensive bill that adds Alaska to four interstate professional licensure compacts. Its purpose is to streamline licensing, improve mobility of health-care workers, and facilitate information sharing among states about license status and disciplinary actions.

The bill authorizes Alaska to join national compacts for physicians, physician assistants, psychologists, and EMS personnel.

The bill would require statutory changes to Alaska licensing boards so they can participate in and administer these compacts.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact; therefore, this is a zero fiscal note.
