FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 362

Analysis

This legislation creates a new license type and full licensing framework for Respiratory Care Practitioners (RCPs) that will be regulated by the department. These licensees must be under the supervision of a qualified medical director, and are authorized to practice in a clinic, hospital, skilled nursing facility, private dwelling, or other location that meets the criteria laid out in the chapter.

If the bill passes the following expenses may be incurred and paid from Receipt Supported Services, fund code 1156. The division will reclassify one vacant Office Assistant 2 into a Licensing Examiner 1 to process applications related to Respiratory Care Practitioners.

If this legislation is adopted, the division will require the following expenditure authority, which will be supported by licensing receipts collected under the program.

Personal Services: \$17.6 Cost for reclassification for one full-time Licensing Examiner 1 (R14)

Travel: \$ 4.0 National association training

Services: \$ 4.5 Legal costs to amend regulations, printing, and postage in FY2027 only
 \$10.0 Legal cost related to investigations
 \$10.0 Hearing and Mediation Costs

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Per AS 08.01.065, licensing fees for each occupation are set, and adjusted biennially as needed, so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
