CS for House Bill 196 (ENE), Renewable Energy Grant Fund
Work Order 34-LS0502I to 34-LS0502G
March 4, 2026

1. Sections 1, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Version I have been removed from Version G. Version I “flipped” the way the Renewable Energy Grant Fund was funded, setting it up as a fund that the Legislature appropriated money *into* rather than a fund that the Legislature appropriates money *out of*, as it is in current statute; these sections implemented that change. Version G makes no change to how Renewable Energy Fund grants are appropriated by the Legislature, and so these sections are removed from the bill.
2. Section 2 in Version I is renumbered to be Section 1 in Version G.
3. Section 4 of Version I is renumbered to be Section 2 in Version G. Additionally, references to the structural change to how grants are appropriated in Section 4 of Version I are removed from Section 2 of Version G.
4. Section 10 of Version I is renumbered to be Section 3 of Version G.
