FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB 316

Analysis

House Bill 316, version A, provides that the current statutory maximum dollar amounts that may be awarded for non-economic damages in a civil lawsuit will be adjusted for inflation. Sections 1 and 2. The bill further specifies that that the maximum amounts of recovery shall be adjusted using 100% of the CPI increase since 1997. Section 3.

The court system handles civil actions for wrongful death and personal injury claims. The statutory maximum amounts in AS 09.17.010 are applied to non-economic damage awards for personal injury or wrongful death, and if HB 316 passes and those statutory amounts are changed, the court will apply the new amounts without fiscal impact.

The court therefore submits this zero fiscal note.
