Dear Representative Carrick:

You have asked how the Criminal Division would prosecute the crime established in HB 250. The Criminal Division would review any referral alleging a violation of HB 250 in the same manner it evaluates any criminal case. Prosecutors would assess the facts and applicable law to determine whether sufficient admissible evidence exists to prove beyond a reasonable doubt that the offense has been committed. This analysis also includes evaluating whether there are any legal defenses or other considerations recognized by law may affect the viability of the prosecution. Based on that review, the Division would determine whether the evidence supports filing criminal charges.
