A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to retirement benefits and military service."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 * **Section 1.** AS 39.35.370(a) is amended to read: 4 (a) Subject to AS 39.35.450, a terminated employee is eligible for a normal retirement benefit 5 6 (1) [AT AGE 60] with at least five years of credited service 7 (A) at age 60; or 8 (B) at any age if the terminated employee is a veteran rated 9 by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs as permanently and 10 totally disabled for a service-connected condition; (2) with at least 20 years of credited service as a peace officer or 11
- 13 (3) with at least 30 years of credited service for all other employees.
- * **Sec. 2.** AS 39.35.340(d), 39.35.340(i), and 39.35.541(b) are repealed.
