

## Alaska's Education Challenge




#### **Five Shared Strategic Priorities:**

gap between urban and rural-remote principals



#### APPRENTICESHIP EMPLOYER

Each district that joins the Statewide Registered Apprenticeship serves as the employer of record.

#### **ROLE TO INCLUDE**

- Pay a progressive wage to the Apprentice according to the approved wage scale
- Provide mentor support according to the requirements of Apprenticeship\*
- Select a Related Instruction Provider from the approved list
- Facilitate Apprenticeship competency evaluation and progress reporting to DEED
- Report Apprenticeship program success metrics to DEED

\*DEED will support districts with solutions where local mentor options are limited



#### APPRENTICESHIP SPONSOR

As the sponsor, DEED serves as the liaison between districts, education preparation programs, and the US Department of Labor.

#### **ROLE TO INCLUDE**

- Compile and submit the Registered Apprenticeship Application and related appendices to the US Department of Labor
- Compile US Department of Labor reporting and submit according to deadlines
- Provide resources to apprentices, employers, and related instruction providers to support effective implementation
- Support mentoring requirements
- Measure Apprenticeship Program success
- Develop program improvements with partner input



## APPRENTICESHIP RELATED INSTRUCTION PROVIDER


The related instruction provider is a DEED approved education preparation program selected by the district as a partner in developing the competencies of the selected Apprentice candidates.

#### **ROLE TO INCLUDE**

- Provide a Related Instruction Outline for inclusion in the Statewide Apprenticeship framework
- Provide related instruction to selected Apprentices, according to agreed upon acceptance process
- Partner with districts to measure Apprentice competency through completed related instruction
- Report Apprenticeship program success metrics to DEED



  - Support District level implementation of District Reading Improvement Plans / Multitiered System of Supports (DRIP/MTSS)
  - Develop and support online opportunities through Virtual Learning Consortium
  - Provide intensive support through evidence-based instructional practices, data analysis, professional development, student-focused scheduling, and effective communication with parents and stakeholders for Department Reading Program schools/districts
- Administer Comprehensive Literacy State Development grant (CLSD) 2024



#### **Career and Technical Education**

- Develop the academic knowledge and technical and employability skills of students to meet challenging academic and technical standards in preparation for high skill, high wage, and in-demand occupations
- Implement the Carl D. Perkins (Perkins V) grants to districts and postsecondary institutions
- Implement State Career and Technical Education (CTE) Allocations
  - Implementation of Career Guide Model
  - Support for CTE programs aligned to regional workforce needs
  - Support for Career and Technical Student Organizations



## **Data and Accountability**

- Collect, analyze, publish, and provide high-quality, accurate, up-to-date information to aid stakeholders in making important education-related decisions
  - Nine (9) data collections per year
- Produce reports and products each year required at the state or federal level:
  - School Accountability Designations
  - State, District, and School Report Cards to the Public
  - Federal EDFacts Reporting
  - Data Center
  - Data Requests



## **Early Learning**

- Support statewide pre-elementary education programs
  - Support pre-elementary programs through grants and technical assistance
  - Implement pre-elementary portion of the Alaska Reads Act
    - Alaska Early Education Program Standards
    - Early Education Program Grant
    - 0.5 ADM Funding
  - Coordinate state activities with Head Start Programs
    - Federal grants from the US Office of Head Start directly to the programs
    - State matching funds through legislative appropriation

## **Health and Safety**

- Create and distribute new resources to expand the inclusion of trauma-engaged practices in schools
- Deepen partnerships for inclusive school environments
- Explore innovative ways to support direct access to school counseling and nursing services
- Implement statewide grant programs to support health, wellness, and school safety, such as:
  - Trauma Engaged Schools
  - School Climate
  - Crisis Response
  - eLearning









## **School Recognition and Support**

- Implement School Improvement Grants
- Employ the Empowerment Process
- Provide Literacy Support
  - Comprehensive Literacy State Development (CLSD)
- Manage Teacher Recognition
  - Teacher of the Year
  - Milken Educator Awards







## **Special Education**

- Implement through Title VI, Part D, Federal funding under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) in Alaska
  - Distribute grants to districts for Special Education programs
  - Distribute federal discretionary grants for special programs and agencies
- Support Alaskan parents, school districts, and students
  - Implement of IDEA requirements
  - Ensure students with disabilities receive free public education (FAPE) in the least restrictive environment
  - Provide guidance and supervision regarding special education compliance requirements



#### Standards and Assessments

- <u>Standards</u>: Support districts and teachers by providing information and resources in content standards implementation
  - Provide professional development
  - Support curriculum alignment
  - Research and disseminate best practices and strategies for effective implementation of standards
- <u>Assessments</u>: Work with district and school staff to ensure successful assessment administration and meaningful use of assessment data
  - Work with vendors to align assessments to Alaska academic standards and federal requirements
  - Provide guidance on effective assessment administration
  - Provide guidance on appropriate use of assessment data
  - Offer professional development on assessment literacy



#### **Teacher Certification**

- Review educator preparation programs and recommends to State Board of Education state approval
- Manage issuance of educator certifications
  - Manage The Educator Application & Certification Hub Alaska (TEACH-AK) online certification system
  - Provide technical assistance and support for districts and educators on TEACH-AK
- Collaborate with the Professional Teaching Practices Commission (PTPC)
   regarding educator adherence to the Code of Ethics of the Education Profession
- Support implementation of Teacher Retention and Recruitment initiatives
