FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2026 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

**Analysis**

House Bill 250 creates a new class B misdemeanor for peace officers who wear masks or disguises while interacting with the public in their official capacity. The law includes exceptions for undercover work, protective gear, medical masks with physician approval, and smoke protection.

The Public Defender Agency does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this bill, as the agency does not anticipate many appointments to cases with this charge. Therefore the Agency submits a zero fiscal note.
