BILL NO. HB 52

Analysis

HB 52 requires the Department of Health to prepare, publish online, and provide to the legislature, an annual report regarding minors placed in psychiatric hospitals. The report includes data provided by the Department of Family and Community Services concerning minors in state custody receiving treatment at in-state and out-of-state psychiatric hospitals. This data is already tracked by the department.

The Department of Family and Community Services, Division of Juvenile Justice, does not anticipate any additional costs associated with providing this data; therefore, a zero fiscal note is submitted. However, the department may lack statutory authority to collect data on minors who are not in its custody for reporting purposes.
