 11 States Department of Health and Human Services for approval the state plan for medical
 12 assistance coverage consistent with AS 47.07.030(b), as amended by sec. 2 of this Act.

13 * **Sec. 4.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
 14 read:

15 **CONDITIONAL EFFECT; NOTIFICATION.** (a) Section 2 of this Act takes effect
 16 only if, on or before January 1, 2027, the United States Department of Health and Human
 17 Services

18 (1) approves the amendment to the state plan for medical assistance coverage
 19 under AS 47.07.030(b); or

20 (2) determines that approval of the amendment to the state plan for medical
 21 assistance coverage under AS 47.07.030(b) is not necessary.

22 (b) The commissioner of health shall notify the revisor of statutes in writing within 30
 23 days after the United States Department of Health and Human Services approves the
 24 amendment to the state plan or determines that approval is not necessary under this section.

6 action that would require the state, under any provision of P.L. 111-148 (Patient
7 Protection and Affordable Care Act), including, 42 U.S.C. 18031(d)(3)(B) or any
8 successor provision, to defray the cost of any coverage for pediatric autoimmune
9 neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric
10 acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome, the requirement that an insurer cover pediatric
11 autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections or
12 pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome under this section becomes
13 inoperative. This subsection does not affect any coverage authorized under 42 U.S.C.
14 1396a (Title XIX, Social Security Act). The state does not assume any obligation for
15 the cost of coverage for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated
16 with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome
17 under this section."
