Work Experience Summary

As Superintendent of Schools for the Bristol Bay Borough School District in Naknek, Alaska, I serve as the chief executive and instructional leader responsible for district-wide vision, operations, and educational excellence. I provide strategic leadership in curriculum and instructional improvement, oversee budgeting and resource allocation, manage personnel recruitment and evaluation, and ensure compliance with state and federal regulations. My role includes advising and supporting the School Board, directing facilities and operational systems, and cultivating strong relationships with staff, families, tribal partners, and community stakeholders. I also represent the district in regional and statewide forums. As a current member of the Professional Teaching Practices Commission, I actively uphold and promote ethical and professional standards for educators across Alaska.
