SB 35 Delivery Network Companies
Summary of Changes
ver. I to ver. H

Section 1: No changes.

Section 2: Undeleted previously deleted language.

Section 3: New section, amending AS 21.96.018(b), making conforming changes and provides circumstances in which an insurer may provide or deny coverage.

Section 4: New section, amending AS 21.96.018(f), referring definitions for the section to definitions made in AS 28.23.180.

Section 5: Renumbered, section 3 of version I.

Section 6: Renumbered, Amends AS 28.23.050(a), to require a company to maintain primary auto insurance while a courier is providing delivery services for a Delivery Network Company, and while a driver is logged into a digital network or engaged in a prearranged ride for a Transportation Network Company.

Section 7: Renumbered, Amends AS 28.23.050(b), making conforming changes and removing language stating coverage may be satisfied by the company or the driver or a combination of both. Additionally adds language that disallows a transportation network company from waiving uninsured or underinsured vehicle coverage.

Section 8: Renumbered, Amends AS 28.23.050(c), making conforming changes.

Section 9-11: Renumbered.

Section 12: Amends AS 28.23.060, making conforming changes.

Section 13-16: Renumbered.

Section 17: Amends AS 28.23.180, changing the definition of “delivery services,” beginning when a courier accepts an offer and ending when the courier returns to where they accepted the order, or when the courier arrives at home, or when the courier begins a personal task unrelated to an order.

Section 18: New section, repeals AS 28.23.050(d).
