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

SUBJECT: Sections Renumbered or Relettered

TO: Users of the 2025 Session Laws of Alaska

Under the authority of AS 01.05.031, as revisor of statutes I have renumbered or relettered certain Alaska Statutes appearing in the 2025 Session Laws of Alaska (SLA) to conform to the arrangement of the Alaska Statutes (AS), to maintain a logical organization of the statutes, and to resolve multiple amendments to particular provisions. The numbering and lettering found in the SLA chapter and the renumbering or relettering that will appear in the 2025 Supplement of the Alaska Statutes are shown below.

(4) members of a patriotic organization licensed under this section that has a reciprocity agreement with another patriotic organization licensed under this section.

* Sec. 4. AS 04.09.220 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(m) A patriotic organization licensed under this section may enter into a reciprocity agreement with another patriotic organization licensed under this section to allow each organization to sell alcoholic beverages to members of both organizations. The decision to enter into a reciprocity agreement shall be made by a majority of members present at a general meeting of each patriotic organization.

* Sec. 5. AS 04.09.250(c) is amended to read:

(c) The holder of a theater license may sell or serve alcoholic beverages only in designated areas on the licensed premises and only for **a period beginning two hours** [ONE HOUR] before the event **until one hour after the event** [AND DURING INTERMISSIONS].

* Sec. 6. AS 04.09.360(c) is amended to read:

(c) The board may issue or renew a license under this section only if

(1) the board determines that

(A) the licensed premises is a bona fide restaurant as defined in AS 04.21.080(b);

(B) there is supervision on the premises adequate to reasonably ensure that a person under 21 years of age will not obtain alcoholic beverages, **except as provided under AS 04.16.049(d)**; and

(C) it is unlikely that persons under 21 years of age not employed on the premises will enter and remain on the licensed premises for purposes other than dining; and

(2) the sale and service of food and alcoholic beverages and any other business conducted on the licensed premises of the restaurant or eating place is under the sole control of the licensee.

* Sec. 7. AS 04.09.360(f) is amended to read:

(f) The board may authorize the holder of a seasonal restaurant or eating place tourism license

(1) to allow a person who is at least 16 years of age but under 21 years of age to enter and remain on the licensed premises for dining only;

(2) to allow a person who is under 16 years of age to enter and remain on the licensed premises for dining only if

(A) the person is accompanied by a person who is 21 years of age or older; and
