## CS HOUSE BILL 133 (34-LS0114\S)

“An Act establishing a 30-day deadline for the payment of contracts under the State Procurement Code; establishing deadlines for the payment of grants, contracts, and reimbursement agreements to nonprofit organizations, municipalities, and Alaska Native organizations; relating to technology upgrades at the Department of Health; and providing for an effective date.”

### EXPLANATION OF CHANGES Version A to CS Version S (Updated 1.30.26)

In the CS relating to prompt payments for HB 133, the provision amending current statute regarding private contractors of public works projects is removed, and the effective date of the measure has been delayed. Otherwise, HB 133 remains unchanged.

HB 133 version S includes several revisions from introduction:

- Page 1, line 4: Addition of intent language to the description.
- Section 2 - Page 3, line 1: All payment deadlines are now 30 days from receipt of invoice, instead of demarcating 30-day deadlines for state funds and 21-day deadlines for federal funds.
- Section 2 - Page 4, line 3: The definition of "grant" is amended to narrow the scope and exclude non-monies.
- Section 2 - Page 4, line 22: Provision of the bill previously entitled "Section 3" is removed. This section required a 20 percent advance of the grant be paid within 10 days. Many agencies already advance a larger percentage to the grantee and this section would have allowed less funding be advanced.
- Section 3 - Page 4, line 23: A new provision is added stating legislative intent that funds from the Rural Health Transformation Program be utilized for any technological update necessary for the Department of Health to successfully implement this Act.
- Section 4 - Page 4, line 29: Delays the effective date to July 1, 2027.
