I hold a Master's degree in Geography, with a specialization in soil geomorphology from Minnesota State University – Mankato, and a double major in Geography and Environmental Studies (with an emphasis on policy and values) from the University of Wisconsin – Oshkosh. My academic background has been deeply rooted in conservation and environmental research, equipping me with a strong scientific foundation, leadership experience, and a comprehensive understanding of environmental systems and climate change. Further complementing this knowledge I was able to conduct seasonal fieldwork in Alaska through Battelle's NEON (National Ecological Observatory Network) project. As a soils field technician, I developed invaluable skills in data collection, field research, and lab analysis, further deepening my understanding of Alaska's unique landscapes.

My passion for soils and conservation of natural resources began on my family's farm in Cochrane, Wisconsin, located in the heart of Buffalo County. Growing up immersed in agriculture, hunting and land stewardship, I developed a deep appreciation for sustainable land use and wildlife management. I actively participated in and observed the impacts of conservation on soils and crop management as well as local populations of waterfowl, whitetail deer, pheasant, and bear, gaining first-hand insight into how thoughtful land management supports healthy ecosystems and sustainable hunting practices.
