Summary of Changes Version A to Version N

HB 217: Autonomous Vehicles

34-LS0950

“An Act relating to autonomous vehicles; and providing for an effective date.”

Section 1, Subsection B (1): The definition of commercial vehicle is added to this subsection. Clarifying that this legislation does not apply to vehicles used for personal, non-commercial use, has a gross weight of 10,000 pounds or less, and is designed to transport not more than 16 passengers including the driver.

Section 1, Subsection E: Clarifies that this legislation does not apply to personal delivery devices that are electrically operated, operated on a sidewalk or path within the right-of-way of a highway, intended primarily to transport property, weighs less than 120 pounds excluding cargo, has a maximum speed of 10 miles per hour, and is equipped with technology to allow for operation of the device with or without the active control or monitoring of an operator who monitors or exercises direct physical control over the navigation system and operation of the device.
