House Bill 308 (34-LS1426\A) Sectional Analysis March 19, 2026

Section 1

Lowers the intoxication threshold for release from a correctional facility from 0.08 to 0.04 BAC before an intoxicated person may be released.

Section 2

Updates the definition of "previously convicted" to include convictions based on a 0.04 BAC standard instead of 0.08.

Section 3

Reduces the per se DUI limit from 0.08 BAC to 0.04 BAC, including equivalent blood and breath alcohol measurements.

Section 4

Updates DUI evidentiary presumptions to reflect the 0.04 BAC standard and removes the former 0.04–0.08 intermediate presumption range.

Section 5

Clarifies the act applies to offenses committed on or after the effective date, while prior convictions still count for repeat offense purposes.

Section 6

Sets the effective date as January 1, 2027.
