Good afternoon, when I began working for the DMV in 2022 I was very surprised to learn that the high risk insurance known as SR22 that is required for many driving offenses, is a lifetime requirement in Alaska even if restitution had been made. I am not referring to repeat or felony offenders, which may have this lifetime requirement. I am referring to persons who have had to repay damages incurred during traffic accidents but continue to be punished with this requirement. I have had customers explain that they have forfeited years of dividends, to pay back their debt and are still required to carry the more expensive insurance. I understand that actions have consequences but to continue to punish individuals after they have repaid their debit is unnecessarily burdensome. I appreciate the legislatures efforts to correct this law.
