My name is Lauryn Baldwin, I live in Anchorage, and my zip code is [REDACTED] I am emailing to show my support for SB 276.

Today, most people on the birth control pill must refill their prescription every month. When a doctor prescribes a year's supply, patients should be able to pick it up, all at once, rather than carving out time once a month to collect their perscription, SB 276 ensures that is the case. This bill would remove barriers to consistent use and help people avoid unintended pregnancies. A year's supply of birth control reduces the odds of experiencing an unintended pregnancy by 30% and reduces the need for abortion care by 46%.

This not only removes barriers to accessing birth control but also gives users autonomy to meet their needs. All Alaskans deserve access to consistent health care.
