## SENATOR BILL WIELECHOWSKI

### Summary of Changes of SB 27 From Version A to Version I

- **Page 1, lines 8, 12 and 14:** Added language to clarify that no component of a product may contain more than 0.1 percent by mass of toxic penta, octa, and deca-BDEs.
- **Page 2, line 6:** Clarified language to ensure that PBDEs would be prohibited through this legislation.
- **Page 3, lines 5-6, 17-23 and 24 to Page 4, line 11:** Removed three sections that would create duplication and inefficiencies when coupled with the interstate chemical clearinghouse. Participation in a multistate chemicals clearinghouse will avoid duplication and enhance efficiency and effectiveness of agency initiatives on chemicals through collaboration and coordination, build governmental capacity to identify and promote safer chemicals and products, and ensure that agencies, businesses and the public have ready access to high quality and authoritative chemicals data, information, and assessment methods.
