HB 77 Summary of Changes

HB77 N (34-LS0144N) to O (34-LS0144O)

"An Act making the theft of mail or an article within mail theft in the second degree."

Section 1: Page 2, delete lines 12 – 19. Removes unnecessary conduct language, simplifying the provision.

Section 2: Adds language to each definition to include “private mail delivery company.”

Section 3: Page 3, Line 11 – 19. These affirmative defenses are unnecessary because the existing definition of theft in statute requires the intent to deprive another of property or to appropriate property/services of another to themselves or a third person. Removing them avoids redundancy and potential legal conflict. The affirmative defense for juvenile treatment, detention, and correctional facilities stays in this section.
