

CSSB 269 Sectional

Section 1 Creates the new board structure and membership qualifications.

Section 2 Establishes 3 regional boards.

Section 3 establishes the boundaries for the 3 regional boards. Also directs the three regional boards to adopt regulations for their respective regions

Section 4 adds the 3 regional fishery boards to the requirement to meet jointly with the Board of Game.

Section 5 establishes clerical assistance for all three regional fishery boards.

Section 6 allows a single regional fish board or more to have a Joint meeting with the Board of Game upon a call from the Commissioner or a board to resolve resource conflicts.

Section 7 sets quorum requirements for the boards.

Section 8 defines “Board of Fisheries”

Section 9 adds the new definition of Board of Fisheries to AS 16.43.990

Section 10 conforming language necessitated by Section 12

Section 11 conforming language necessitated by Section 12

Section 12 allows a Board of Fish member to be involved in deliberations and voting once they have declared a conflict of interest. This will be handled just like the Legislature does it during floor session.

Section 13 Transition language for current board members

Section 14 Transition language for DF&G and Board of Fisheries to adopt regulations.

Section 15,16 Sets effective dates
