HB 25: Restrict Restaurant Use of Polystyrene Sectional Analysis Ver. A

Section 1

Creates a new section in Alaska Statute, AS 17.20, the Alaska Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.

AS 17.20.035(a) A restaurant may not use polystyrene foam disposable food ware.

- (b) The State may not use or purchase polystyrene foam disposable food ware.
- (c) Restaurants using disposable food service ware shall use biodegradable or compostable products unless they receive an exemption from the state.
- (d) The Department of Environmental Conservation shall recommend that restaurants use reusable food service ware in place of disposable when possible.
- (e) The restriction in (a) shall not apply to prepared food packaged out of state, polystyrene coolers intended for reuse, or areas affected by a disaster emergency.
- (f) A restaurant may apply to DEC for an exemption if there is not an affordable replacement or it would cause undue hardship.
- (g) Defines terms in the new section.
