Senate Bill 265

Sectional Analysis — Version I

“An Act relating to the duty of an operator immediately after an accident”

Section 1

AS 28.35.060 Duty of operator to give information and render assistance.

Amends AS 28.35.060(b) to create felony charges for the failure to render assistance when the accident causes injury under section (c) or death under section (d).

Section 2

AS 28.35.060 Duty of an operator to give information and render assistance.

Amends AS 28.35.060(c) to specify the charge of failure to render assistance with an injury is a class B felony under Title 12.

Section 3

AS 28.35.060 Duty of an operator to give information and render assistance.

Adds subsection (d) to establish the penalty for failing to render reasonable assistance by the operator when death occurs to a class A felony under Title 12 with a presumptive sentence of seven to eleven years if found guilty of criminally negligent homicide under AS 11.41.130 or AS 11.41.170 for the same action.

Section 4

Uncodified law

Stating this Act applies to crimes committed on or after the effective date.
