Hi Konrad,

Glenn Haight here.

Sorry, but I can't help myself.

I pointed to the process a little in the fiscal note, but to be put a fine point on it.

Let's assume it passes and is signed into law by July 1 or thereabouts. CFEC will need to run through a proposed regulation process. The timeline will be tight but given the bill's direction it could be done and effective well prior to January 1. The proposed regulation would include the application process timeline and requirements. Pretty simple. I would envision the application process would start at least by November 1.

CFEC would need to inform the applicants by January 1 whether or not they are in the new administrative area. If not, and they object, they have effectively 60 days to appeal to the Superior Court. Sixty days is the recognized timeline for an appeal of an administrative action.

Annual permit renewals typically start in November the year prior. Basically as soon as the CFEC licensing system can be turned over. If there is an April related timeline for the ESSN, it is likely an ADFG registration timeline.
