FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. SB 247

Analysis

SB 247 creates two new crimes: *Distribution of Generated Obscene Child Sexual Abuse Material* and *Possession of Generated Obscene Child Sexual Abuse Material*. The legislation also expands the existing crime of *Possession of Child Sexual Abuse Material* to include material that depicts or represents child sexual abuse of an actual child through manipulation, creation, or modification.

These new crimes codify and provide legal clarity prohibiting the use of artificial intelligence or other generative technologies to create artificial images of child sexual abuse material.

The Department of Family and Community Services, Division of Juvenile Justice, will respond to delinquency referrals for these new crimes based on the individual needs of juveniles and their families, as well as the needs of victims and affected communities. No fiscal impact is anticipated; therefore, a zero fiscal note is submitted.
