


# HB 47 GENERATED CSAM; GEN IMAGES, SOCIAL MEDIA

Criminalizes the creation or distribution of forged digital likenesses and AI-generated sexual depictions without consent, including explicit images involving minors.

**CSHB 47 strengthens Alaska's criminal law to:**

- Criminalize Generated Child Sexual Abuse Material
- Update Adult Deepfake and Forged Digital Likeness Crimes
- Create Civil Penalties for Facilitating CSAM
- Add Social Media and Minor Protection Provisions
- Make Conforming Amendments: Positions of Trust

- Creates demand for harmful content.
- Blurs legal boundaries for enforcement.
- Overwhelming law enforcement's capabilities to identify and rescue real-life victims.

## **Distribution of Forged Digital Likeness**

- Intent to defraud, harass, threaten, or intimidate
- Actual identifiable individual
- Class A misdemeanor

## **Distribution of Generated Sexual Depictions**

- Distribution that may result in physical, emotional, relational, or economic harm
- Unauthorized participation
- Class A misdemeanor

## **Harassment in the first degree**

- Published or distributed electronic photos of a person engaged in a sexual act

## INCREASE IN AI-GENERATED CSAM:

Analysts have also seen a “frightening” 26,362% rise in photo-realistic AI videos of child sexual abuse, often including real and recognisable child victims. In 2025, the IWF discovered 3,440 AI videos of child sexual abuse compared to only 13 in 2024.

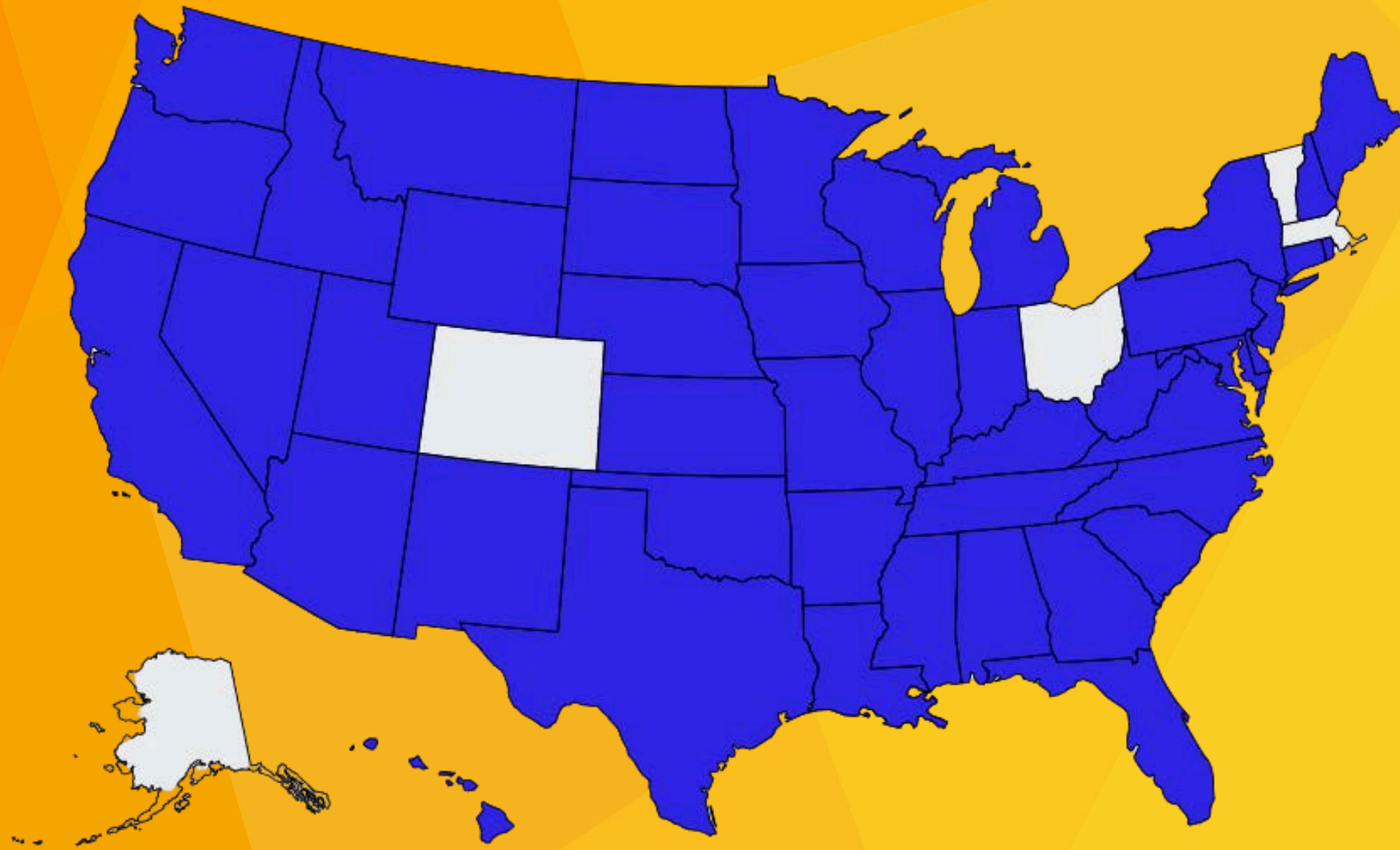
## AI CSAM FEATURING KNOWN VICTIMS:

Perpetrators increasingly use fine-tuned AI models to generate new imagery of known victims of child sexual abuse or famous children.

## MORE SEVERE IMAGES:

Of the AI-generated images confirmed to be child sexual abuse on the forum, more images depicted the most severe Category A abuse, indicating that perpetrators are more able to generate complex ‘hardcore’ scenarios.

# State Laws that Criminalize AI-generated or Computer-edited CSAM



Research by ENOUGH ABUSE™ has documented that **45 states** have enacted laws that criminalize AI-generated or computer-edited CSAM, while 5 states and D.C. have not.

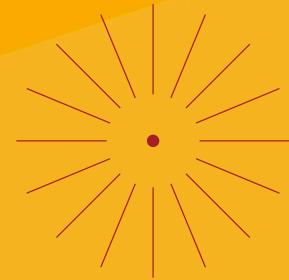
The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) has reported a dramatic surge in AI-related exploitation, including a **1,325% increase** in CyberTipline reports involving generative AI between 2023 and 2024, reaching tens of thousands of reports.

# ALASKA SOCIAL MEDIA REGULATION ACT

- User age verification and parental consent
  - Parental access to minor's account
  - Advertising to minor users prohibited
  - Content targeting minor users is prohibited
  - Addictive features for minor users are prohibited
  - Curfew for minors
  - Private right of action

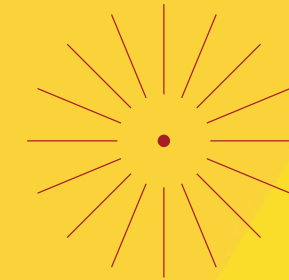
