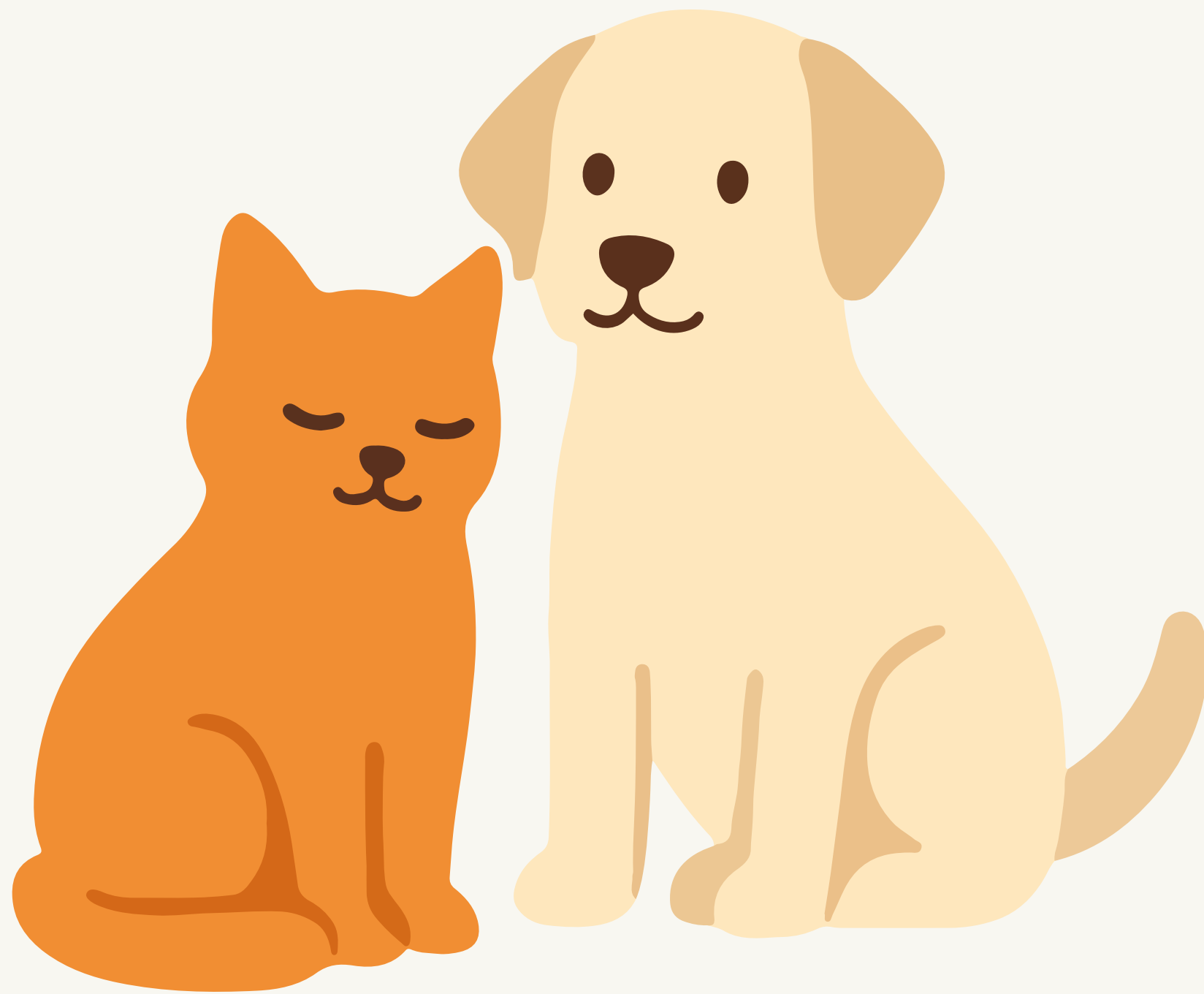




House Bill 335 - Disaster Emergency Plan for Pets



What is HB 335?

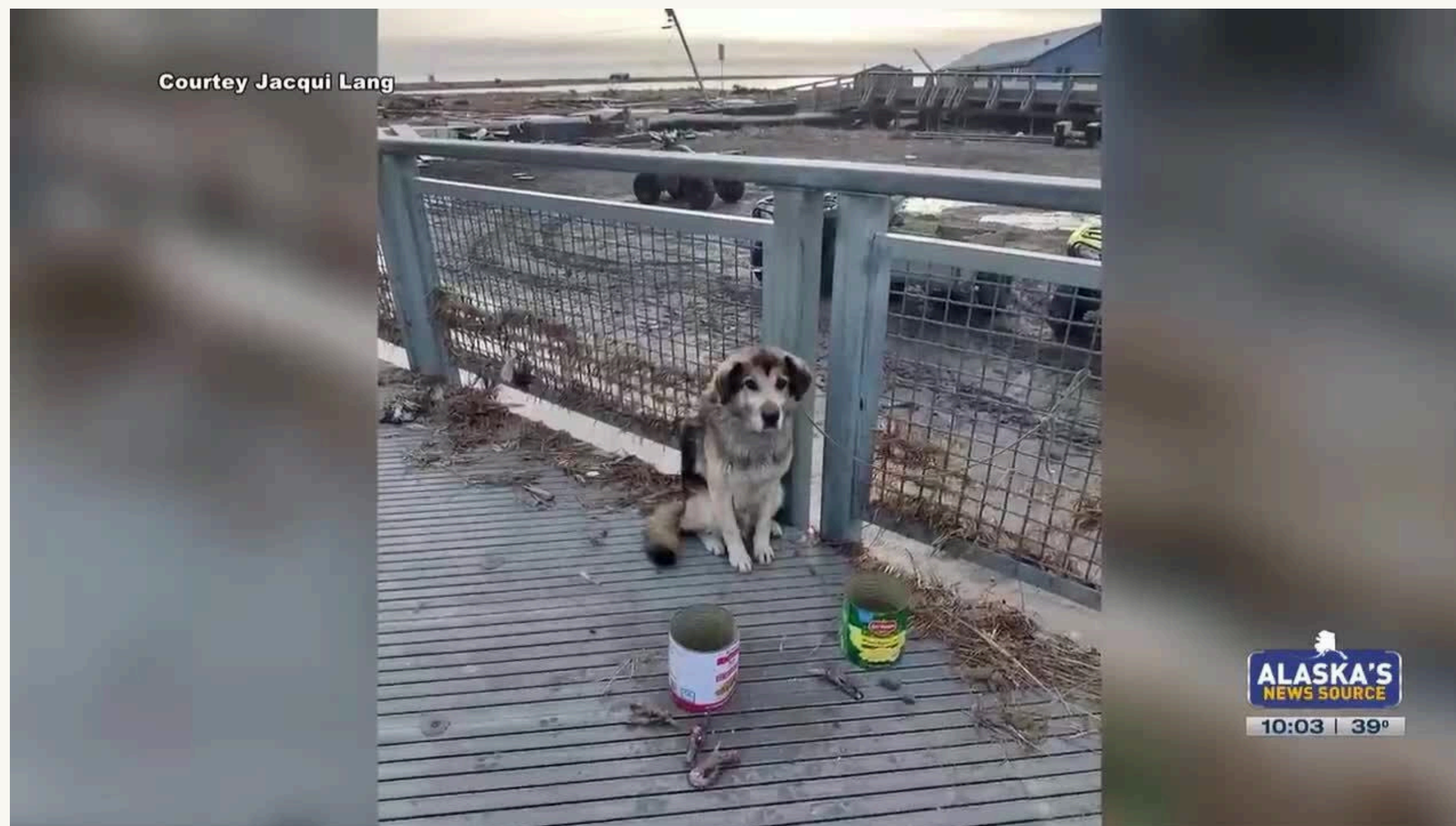
A revision and clarification of current laws to streamline the rescue of pets and service animals.

Why It Matters?

Recent emergencies have shown that Alaska's disaster response plans are unclear as related to pets and service animals, leading to confusion and disorganization.

How does HB 335 solve the Problem?

- Disaster response plans are clearly defined and detailed
- Animal rescue is planned
- Veterinary response abilities are strengthened
- Reunification is easier



Alaskans' lives are intertwined with companion animals, we owe it to them to rescue and safeguard them.

Human victims of natural disasters recover more quickly and have better outcomes when reunited with their pets.
