SUBJECT: FY27 Hardware Refresh Recommendations

Below is the annualized FY27 computer hardware refresh recommendation for Council's consideration.

The list is based on a five-year computer equipment refresh cycle, equipment age, upkeep costs, performance, and end of life. The recommendations:

- Are consistent with the Four-Year Technology Plan.
- Meet the hardware refresh requirements for: Legislative Affairs, Legislative Offices, Ombudsman's, Office of Victim's Rights, Ethics, and Legislative Finance.
- Continues to allow maintenance/replacement of aging color printers, standardizing on a single model for each office, reducing toner replacement and repair/maintenance costs
- Allows continued replacement of the aging Lenovo Yoga laptops.
- Allows replacement of end-of-life Lenovo Tiny PCs used by production staff.
- Are in-line with the Apple iPad refresh policy.
- Are cost-efficient, leveraging government contract volume discount pricing.

MOTION: I move that Legislative Council approve the FY27 computer hardware refresh expenditure of \$232,024 out of existing capital funds.
