FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

House Bill 314 would clarify who is authorized to install or modify small septic systems in Alaska (sized to receive not more than 1,500 gallon per days.) The Department of Environmental Conservation regulates onsite wastewater systems under Alaska Statute Title 46, while professional licensing requirements are addressed under Alaska Statute Title 08. Although these statutes and the associated regulations are not directly in conflict, differing interpretations by statewide professional organizations have led to confusion regarding who may perform certain types of septic system work.

The bill would align statutory language with the existing regulatory framework housed within the department's Division of Water's Certified Installer Program. Under the program, individuals must meet specific training, testing, and qualification requirements to install or modify small onsite wastewater systems.

As written, the Department of Environmental Conservation can implement this clarification within existing resources.
