Analysis

This bill allows individuals aged 18 through 20 to sell, serve, deliver, or dispense alcoholic beverages on certain licensed premises; removes supervision of individuals aged 18 through 20; and amends the warning sign requirements for alcoholic beverage licensed premises to require the posting of a warning that "Alcohol use can cause cancer, including breast and colon cancers."	С
If this legislation is adopted, the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office (AMCO) will need to update the online licensing and case management systems and updating regulations. These changes will be incorporated into planned system updates and regulations packages.	
AMCO prints required warning signs and provides them to alcoholic beverage licensees. If adopted, this bill would require AMCO to replace existing signs. In addition, AMCO will need to update and notice associated regulations. The cost of these changes will be absorbed within AMCO's existing authority.	ē
