SB 247 Version A to CSSB 247 (CRA) Version N

Computer-Generated Child Sexual Abuse Material

Summary of Changes

The Senate Community & Regional Affairs Committee adopted the following changes:

- 1) **Title Change** – Adds “relating to sexual abuse of a minor; relating to enticement of a minor; relating to unlawful exploitation of a minor;”
- 2) **New Section 4** – Amends unlawful exploitation of a minor to include possession and/or distribution of material in which a child comes into contact with semen. (DPS request)
- 3) **New Section 1** – incorporates language in Sec. 4 into the crime of sexual abuse of a minor in the second degree.
- 4) **New Section 2** – incorporates language in Sec. 4 into the crime of enticement of a minor.
- 5) **New Section 3** – incorporates language in Sec. 4 into the crime of enticement of a minor, stating that the prosecution doesn’t have to prove the contact was actually committed for it to be considered enticement.

6) New Section 5 – incorporates language in Sec. 4 into the crime of harassment in the first degree as an exemption; that conduct falls into other categories of crime, but not harassment.

7) Section 7 – Clarifies that the crime of CSAM distribution requires “knowingly” distributing. (Page 4, Line 25)

a. Page 5, Line 21 – incorporates language in Sec. 4 into the conduct included in generated CSAM possession.

8) Section 9 – incorporates language in Sec. 4 into the conduct included in CSAM possession.

9) New Section 21 – Adds possession and distribution of generated CSAM to the list of registerable sex offenses. (DOL request)

10) Section 27 – Adds the new sections of the bill to the applicability section, noting that they will impact crimes committed on or after the effective date.
