This bill would add the requirement for all students in grade nine through 12 to complete a one-half credit hour financial literacy course. The Department of Education and Early Development (DEED) would be required to approve courses to meet this requirement. |

| This fiscal note contains three one-time expenses: 1) \$30.0 for stipends (\$1.5 each) for 20 educators and community stakeholders for participation in the development of a rubric to evaluate courses, and to complete the review based on the developed rubric; 2) \$35.0 to contract an education expert to facilitate the development of a rubric and evaluation of courses; and, 3) \$6.0 for legal fees to implement the necessary regulation changes. |
