### HB 239: CRIM. NEG. HOMICIDE; FAILURE TO ASSIST Overview of Changes from Version I to Version G

#### Changes to HB 239: CRIM. NEG. HOMICIDE; FAILURE TO ASSIST

Section 47, 61, 62, 63

- Delete HB 239 version I sec. 1-3, 5-6, amend Sec. 4
- Insert new sections that read:

\* **Sec. 61.** AS 28.35.060(b) is amended to read:

(b) Except as provided in (c) **or (d)** of this section, a person who fails to 4 comply with any of the requirements of this section is, upon conviction, punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$500, or by both. This provision does not apply to a person incapacitated by the accident to the extent that the person is physically incapable of complying with the requirement.

\* **Sec. 62.** AS 28.35.060(c) is amended to read:

(c) A person who fails to comply with a requirement of this section regarding 10 assisting an injured person is, upon conviction, **guilty of a class B felony**, punishable **as provided in AS 12.55** [BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 YEARS, OR BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000, OR BY BOTH]. This provision does not apply to a person incapacitated by the accident to the extent that the person is physically incapable of complying with the requirement.

\* **Sec. 63.** AS 28.35.060 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(d) A person who fails to comply with a requirement of this section regarding failure to render reasonable assistance is, upon conviction, guilty of a class A felony punishable as provided in AS 12.55. This provision does not apply to a person incapacitated by the accident to the extent that the person is physically incapable of complying with the requirement.

\* **Sec. 77.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

APPLICABILITY. AS 28.35.060(b), as amended by sec. 61 of this Act, 11 AS 28.35.060(c), as amended by sec. 62 of this Act, and AS 28.35.060(d), enacted by sec. 63 of this Act, apply to offenses committed on or after the effective date of this Act.

- Amends the close-in-age gap for 16-and17-year olds sending and receiving sexual/explicit text messages to 6 years, to be aligned with the close-in-age gap for sexual intercourse under HB 101.

**Incorporates House Bill 62: SEXUAL ASSAULT EXAMINATION KITS/TRACKING**

Section 52, 66, 68, 67, 69, 70 71.

Includes all of HB 62 version A.

**Incorporates House Bill 242: SEXUAL ASSAULT BY HEALTH CARE WORKER**

Sections 7, 8.

Includes all of HB 242 version A.

**Incorporates Senate Bill 17: CRIME COUNTERFEIT/NONFUNCTIONING AIRBAG**

Section 64.

Includes all SB 17 version N.

**Incorporates Senate Bill 233: CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Section 38.

Includes all of SB 233 version A with the following change:

- Clarifies the Controlled Substance Advisory Committee is established under the division of the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development that the Controlled Substances Advisory Committee with responsibility for corporations, business, and professional licensing.

**Incorporates Senate Bill 100: THEFT: ORGANIZED; MED. RECORDS; MAIL**

Sections 19, 20, 21, 43

Includes all of SB 100 version A.

**Incorporates HB 384: DEFINITION OF 'VICTIM COUNSELING CENTER'**

Section 59.

Includes all of HB 384 version A.

**Incorporates HB 81: ACCESS TO MARIJUANA CONVICTION RECORDS**

Sections 53, 54.

Includes all of HB 81 version I.
