Senate Bill 9: SURRENDER OF INFANTS; INF. SAFETY DEVICE

"An Act relating to the surrender of infants; and providing for an effective date."

Explanation of Changes

Senate Bill 9: Version G to Version T

Page 2, line 15-17:

Removes the authority of the Commissioner of the Department of Family to designate additional appropriate locations for an infant safety device beyond the approved listed designated facilities as requested by the department.

Page 4, lines 4-8:

Deletes assessment considerations for determining whether to approve a proposed infant safety device and adds the requirement that the infant safety device must be installed, operated, and maintained according to the manufacturer's guidelines and regulations that are adopted by the Department.

Adds that the infant safety devices must be inspected upon installation and annually by the manufacturer or the manufacture's designee, and inspected monthly by the designated facility that installed the device. These inspections are required to be logged by the designated facility and must include the testing of the device's alarms, cameras, climate control systems, and locks.
