## A Therapeutic Community

### What is the *Nu'iju* Healing Place?

The *Nu'iju* Healing Place is a 12-18 month therapeutic community located in the Palmer Correctional Center, medium security facility designed to change negative core beliefs. The culturally rooted, trauma informed program is based on the belief that change is possible and that we heal as whole people — body, mind, emotions, and spirit.

#### Focus areas include:

- Addiction recovery
- Trauma education and healing
- Relationships and communication
- Reentry

### What is the application process for a coordinator/participant?

NHP welcomes all individuals pursuing personal wellness to apply for participation, regardless of cultural affiliation, beliefs, observances, or practices.

#### Applicant requirements:

- Applicant must fully commit to the NHP process.
- Applicant must be open to personal accountability.
- Applicant must desire to create deep and lasting change.
- Applicant must have no write-ups or disciplinary actions in the last six months.

Ask your institutional probation officer for an application today, complete the application and return it to them upon completion.

Once it is received, qualifications will be reviewed, and interviews will be scheduled.

### The Meaning of *Nu'iju*

Family Wellness Warriors derives its gifted Dena'ina name, *Nu'iju*, from a word that means “returning to our (true) selves.”

The word **return** also promises the hope of one day returning as a whole person to family and community, which is the goal of any kind of recovery.
