Statement of Changes from SB 167 (ver. I) to CSSB 167 (JUD) (ver. G)

PFD ELIGIBILITY; PFD FOR OVERTURN CONVIC.

“An Act relating to eligibility of criminal offenders for certain benefits, including the permanent fund dividend; relating to a permanent fund dividend for an individual whose conviction has been vacated, reversed, or dismissed; and relating to the calculation of the value of the permanent fund dividend by including payment to individuals eligible for a permanent fund dividend because of a conviction that has been vacated, reversed, or dismissed.”

Sections 1, 4, 5, and 6 from previous version removed in their entirety.

Section 1. Substantially similar to Section 2 of previous version. Restores PFD eligibility for individuals whose convictions were vacated or reversed and establishes application procedures for claiming past PFDs. Adds that a prior transfer to the restorative justice account does not disqualify an otherwise eligible individual from receiving those past PFDs.

Section 2. Renumbered Section 3 from previous version. Substantively identical.

Section 3. Renumbered Section 7 from previous version. Substantively identical.
