### Amendments for Consideration – Wednesday, April 22, 2026

#### **House Bill 335: Disaster Emergency Plans for Pets**

##### Amendment 1 (A.2) – Rep. Carrick:

- Adds working animals to the list of animals which are to be included in the evacuation planning, defines working animal as a dog primarily used for mushing and a horse used for business purposes.

##### Amendment 2 (A.3) – Rep. Carrick

- Adds working animal and livestock to the list of animals which are to be included in evacuation planning, leaves the definition of working animal and livestock up to (likely) the Department of Military & Veteran Affairs.

##### Amendment 3 (A.4) – Rep. Carrick

- Adds a section which relates to the provision of information about the animal identification system, including microchipping.

##### Amendment 4 (A.7) – Rep. Saddler

- Eliminates bill provisions requiring a public information campaign

##### Amendment 5 (A.8) – Rep. Saddler

- Requires microchipping as well as a detailed annual report

##### Amendment 6 (A.10) – Rep. Saddler

- Changes language and removes a section

##### Amendment 7 (A.6) – Rep. Saddler

- Establishes a microchipping program

- Adjusts the maximum claim amounts, and removes the inflation adjustment formula

#### **House Bill 292: Insurance: Pediatric Neuropsych Disorders**

##### Amendment 1 (G.1) – Rep. Fields :

- Deletes “consortium” and replaces it with “nationally recognized clinical practice guidelines,” and adds a definition

##### Amendment 2 (G.2) – Rep. Fields

- Changes “health benefit plan” to “health care insurance plan”

### Amendments for Consideration – Wednesday, April 22, 2026

#### **Senate Bill 180: LNG Import Facilities**

##### Amendment 1 (I.2) – Rep. Hall:

- Shortens timelines for orders issued by the RCA, from 270 days to 180 days for filings that do not impact rates; and from 450 days to 270 days for filings that do impact rates.

##### Amendment 2 (I.3) – Rep. Fields

- Adds provisions from HB 164 (N Version), to remove existing statutory caps for net metering programs.

##### Amendment 3 (I.5) – Rep. Fields

- Adds provisions from SB 32 to provide an exemption to RCA approval for small renewable energy projects under 8 MW.
