FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

BILL NO. HB371

Analysis

This bill provides a campaign financial disclosure reporting exemption for political groups that raise and spend no more than \$5,000 in a calendar year; implements a new disclosure requirement for candidates who receive bundled campaign contributions; requires persons engaged in election activities to have a physical address in Alaska, or identify an individual resident agent with an address in Alaska; implements a \$3,000 limit on contributions made to independent expenditure groups; implements registration requirement, more frequent reporting regime, and new communication identifiers for groups and persons who receive the majority of their funding from non-resident persons and individuals; increases reporting frequency for persons making independent expenditures; and devalues used campaign signs after an election.

The Alaska Public Offices Commission submits a zero fiscal note.
