BILL NO. SB 169

Analysis

This legislation requires each executive branch principal department to designate one staff member to serve as a liaison between the department and the Welcoming Alaska Office (WAO). The liaison shall disseminate information about services offered by the department that are available to new immigrants and newcomers, department staff, the WAO, and the public. The liaison shall also communicate with the WAO on issues affecting new immigrants and newcomers, as well as, when applicable, coordinate between the WAO, the department, and professional boards within the liaison's department to assist the WAO with license applications from new immigrants and newcomers.

These duties and functions can be absorbed within department's current budgets, therefore, a zero fiscal note is being submitted. Costs associated with establishing the WAO are reflected in a separate fiscal note from the Department of Labor and Workforce Development.
