Dear Ms. Levy and Board:

Introduction

This is to let you know that I am amazed that Mr. Hickerson denied my financial eligibility in a letter dated August 11, 2000 and his decision to my knowledge was concurred with by the Grievance Committee of Alaska Legal Services Corporation on September 19. I am being harassed primarily by Mr. Howard Trickey, who wants to keep his "grave train" as Counsel, Anchorage School Board, per his 11 Pages "Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief" dated December 8, 1999 in behalf of Mr. Bob Christal, former Superintendent, ASD, who continues to harass me. Judge Hensley intends to hold a non-jury trial against me per enclosed Attachment 1 September 11, 2000 complaint to Alaska Commission on Judicial Conduct after he established an entire year long timetable for going forward with his "kangaroo court" set to commence on June 11, 2001.

I have been attempting to obtain legal representation for more than six months having gone to Alaska Bar Association Lawyer Referral which I later found out does not include Pro Bono representation and American Civil Liberties Union to no avail. In the case of Alaska Civil Liberties Union, I have been denied any assistance and have not so much as been provided the name/s of the Board of Directors although I have asked for it several times. I wrote Ms. Mary Geddes and Mr. Randall Burns in March, 2000 to ask for their help as past leaders of the AKCLU without response. I was dumfounded September 15, 2000 at Board Meeting of Anchorage Chamber of Commerce when Mr. Allan Tesche, Attorney, arose and allowed that he is past President, AKCLU, as he was asking for support for my Orders of Exclusion and Conduct Orders enclosed Attachment 3. I should be a prime candidate for representation by Alaska Legal Services and yet my request was denied outright.

Eligibility

My treatment by Alaska Legal Services Corporation smacks of yet another "set up." I read to the Grievance Committee on September 19 Page 2 of Summer 2000 Newsletter for Alaska Legal Services entitled "Alaska Pro Bono Program To Become Separate Organization" where it states: "APBP will have the ability to take on a broader range of cases." Ms. Marie-Elena Walsh was not invited to the Grievance Committee Meeting and I have not been allowed to find out how to get in touch with her by the Executive Director.

Dear Ms. Obermyer:

On May 28, 2003 at approximately 2:30 pm you came uninvited to the reception area of the Anchorage office of Alaska Legal Services Corporation (ALSC) and demanded to see an employee about a matter not related to the employee's work or ALSC. When the receptionist informed you that you must make an appointment in advance to see the employee you threw your eyeglasses and struck the receptionist. You also raised your voice and spoke to the receptionist in a threatening manner. The supervising attorneys then instructed you to leave but you refused until the police were called. You left ALSC before the police arrived.

Given the above, and the fact that we are obligated to provide our employees and clients with a safe environment, we are informing you that you are no longer welcome in the Anchorage office of ALSC. Should you again come uninvited to Alaska Legal Services Corporation, 1016 W. 6th Avenue, Suite 200, Anchorage, Alaska 99501 we will immediately notify the police and have a complaint made against you for trespass. Should you ever become income eligible for our free legal services, an over the phone intake can be conducted.

You are hereby advised that you may appeal this notice to the Board of Directors of ALSC by sending a written request to Andy Harrington, Executive Director, ALSC, 1648 Cushman St. #300, Fairbanks, Alaska 99701-6206. However, this notice remains in effect during the pendency of an appeal should you decide to file one. Your written request must describe the grounds for your appeal.

Alaska Legal Services Corporation files civil lawsuits on behalf of indigent Alaskans. I am indigent because of the enclosed "Interested Persons Report" and request legal representation. Please note per my "Interested Persons Report" #4 Pages 8, 9, 10, & 11 is my acquittal in a seven day jury trial State of Alaska vs. Theresa Nangle Obermeyer 3AN-S98-2211 CR. I have numerous documents about my acquittal including the tapes and log notes of the trials and a transcript of my Violent Crimes Compensation Board Claim 98-365 which I filed on 2/23/98 after my invitation to Anchorage Hilton on 2/20/98 to be pushed into a concrete floor waking up in a pool of blood and having to have seven stitches in the back of my head.

Please let me know if you are interested in discussing my possible representation in this matter.
