HB260: Certificate of Fitness / Unpaid Construction Wages

Summary of Changes made in House Labor and Commerce

Version N to Version I

34LS1242\I

- Change #1** Changes the timing of a contractor’s license suspension and revocation for violating the certificate of fitness statutes. A 90-day suspension is now after a second violation, and a permanent revocation after a third violation. Adds a notice requirement for potential suspension and revocation. The \$1,000 fine could also potentially be assessed on both a contractor and a subcontractor for the same violation.
- Change #2** Removed a reference to “employee” from Section 2. The administrative fine for violating the certificate of fitness statutes would only apply to employers of the unlicensed employee, not the employee themselves.
- Change #3** In Sec. 3, AS 23.10.720(b), changes from “may” to “shall” the requirement that a subcontractor provide payroll records to an employee’s authorized representative under certain circumstances.
