CS HB 214 (34-LS0602\I)

“An Act relating to proof of financial responsibility for suspension for nonpayment of judgments.”

Sectional Analysis

Section 1

This section amends AS 28.20.330(b) to establish a tiered system for the length of time a person must maintain proof of financial responsibility after a suspension for nonpayment of a judgment. A person with a first suspension is required to maintain proof for one year after the judgment is stayed or satisfied. For subsequent suspensions, the required period increases to three years for a second suspension, 10 years for a third suspension, and for a fourth or subsequent suspension, for as long as the person holds a driver's license or nonresident operating privilege.

Section 2

This section provides that the changes made in sec. 1 of this Act apply to suspensions occurring before, on, or after the effective date of the Act.

Section 3

This section requires insurance companies doing business in the state to notify customers who are required to maintain proof of financial responsibility of the provisions of this Act within six months after the effective date.
