FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation addresses three items to assist in the implementation of Executive Order 121 which reorganized the Department of Health and Social Services: authorization for sharing "identifiable health information" between departments; clarifying which departments are responsible for licensing runaway shelters and foster homes; and the addition of the Department of Family and Community Services Commissioner to the Mental Health Trust Authority Board of Advisors.	
This legislation is important to assist the implementation of EO 121 to reorganized the former Department of Health and Social Services. Implementation of the bill will have no fiscal or programmatic impact on the department.
