## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

### Analysis

This bill will allow persons at least 16 years of age and under 18 years of age to preregister to vote. It requires the Division of Elections (division) to send a notice by non-forwardable mail to confirm the address of a preregistered person 90 days before the person reaches 18 years of age. The notice must include a postage prepaid return card on which the person may state the person's current address. If the person returns the card, the division shall register the person when the person reaches 18 years of age and mail them a voter registration card.

The division will need to develop a technical solution for the statewide voter registration and election management system (VREMS) to accommodate this new group of future voters. Because the division is building a new voter registration system and can integrate these changes as part of the build, there will not be a cost for the technical solution.

The division will revise voter registration forms and the online voter registration system to include the designation of preregistration. These changes will be absorbed into regular updates and as part of the voter registration system build-out.

The July 2024 Alaska population estimate for 16-year-olds is 10,303. Assuming all 10,303 preregistered to vote, the cost to mail the non-forwardable notice would be \$7,512 (10,303 x 0.73 postage), with an additional cost of \$7,512 for the postage prepaid return card for a total estimated annual cost of \$15,042.

The division will adopt regulations for the process to confirm the residence addresses of preregistered voters before registering them to vote.
