Tanana Chiefs Conference

- Tribal Consortium composed of 42 members;37 federally recognized tribes
- 6% of Federally Recognized Tribes
- Our Region covers 235,000
 square miles in interior Alaska,
 Slightly smaller than state
 of Texas
- 9 communities on the Road-System

TCC Energy Landscape

Utilities in our Region

- Alaska Village Electric Cooperative serves 8 villages
- AP&T serves 10
- Village Corporations serve 3 (MTNT Ltd, GZ Corp. TDX)
- Independent utilities serve 15 of our communities
- GVEA serves Nenana

Price Breakdown

- Average price of fuel: \$7.02 / Gallon
 - Fuel is ~50% of the total expenditure of the Utility
- Average price of electricity (\$/kWh) = \$0.80/kWh ->
 \$0.27/kWh effective


\$131 Million Dollars "at-risk"

Hughes, Alaska

- 120 kW Solar PV Array
- 350 kW/250 kWh Battery Storage System
- ~60,000 gallons of Diesel a year before solar/BESS
- ~50,000 gallons of Diesel a year after solar/BESS
 - \$10,000 gallons saved ~ \$90,000 saved
- 12 hours of diesel's off time in Sunny Months ~
 \$5,000 in maintenance savings/annually
