A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to substitute teaching; and relating to the qualifications of school
2 board members."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 14.08.041 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

5 (g) Notwithstanding AS 14.14.140, a member of a regional school board may
6 be employed as a substitute teacher at a school under emergency circumstances of a
7 time-limited duration.

8 * **Sec. 2.** AS 14.12.080 is amended to read:

9 **Sec. 14.12.080. Qualification of members.** To be eligible to be a member of a
10 school board, a person must have the same qualifications as are necessary to be a
11 municipal voter in the school district **and may not have been convicted of a felony**
12 **involving moral turpitude unless the person has been unconditionally discharged**
13 **for the felony and at least 10 years have passed since the date of unconditional**
14 **discharge. In this section, "unconditionally discharged" has the meaning given in**
