SB 204 – Substitute Teaching; School Board Eligibility

Explanation of Changes: Version A to Version G

Section 1 – Version A sought to amend AS 14.08.041 to allow a member of a regional school board to be employed as a substitute teacher. Version G adds a further stipulation that allows a regional school board member to be employed as a substitute teacher “under emergency circumstances of a time-limited duration.”

Section 2 – Version G adds clarifying language to AS 14.12.080 to prevent a person from serving as a school board member if the person has been convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude, unless the person has been unconditionally discharged for the felony and at least 10 years have passed since the date of unconditional discharge. Version G stipulates that “unconditional discharge” means that a defendant is released from all disability arising under a sentence, including probation and parole.

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
