A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to data sharing by the Department of Administration."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* **Section 1.** AS 28.05.068(b) is amended to read:

(b) Notwithstanding (a) of this section, the department may [NOT] convey, distribute, or communicate data to a private entity only to confirm the information of an individual who has voluntarily provided the individual's state driver's license or identification card [ANY SCANNED OR STORED DOCUMENTS COLLECTED] in order to carry out the provisions of AS 28.15.151(g) [AS 28.15].

* **Sec. 2.** AS 28.15.151 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(g) The department shall, upon request, furnish information maintained by the department under this section to

(1) a nonprofit organization or governmental or tribal entity approved by the United States Social Security Administration to facilitate driver's license data verification; in this subsection, "nonprofit organization" means an organization that qualifies for exemption from taxation under 26 U.S.C. 501(c)(3) or (4) (Internal

(2) an entity participating in the Transportation Security Administration's Registered Traveler Programs; information provided under this paragraph shall be used for lawful purposes and is not limited to use within a program if the entity receives the information in order to facilitate driver's license or identification card data verification and the individual has voluntarily provided their driver's license or identification card.
