**Analysis**

This bill establishes an Address Confidentiality Program (ACP) to protect the physical location of eligible individuals by allowing them to use a state-designated substitute address. The Division of Motor Vehicles can implement the required processes within existing operations by accepting ACP substitute addresses when allowable. The division can absorb these duties within current capacity, resulting in a zero-dollar fiscal note.
